YOUR AskEdgewater REQUEST MUST INCLUDE:

- The number of affected trees.
- Any details that you can provide about specific concerns.
- Note you'd like an inspection from the City Arborist.

The City Arborist will visit the property within 10 business days and confirm eligibility for the Healthy Tree Canopy Program.

You will receive your coupon at this time.



2023 COUPONS 50% up to \$500 (max) on services per property.

If eligible, the City Arborist will provide the resident with a coupon to use in the 2023 calendar year for 50% up to \$500 (max) of any eligible service - one coupon per property. The removal or treatment must be provided by the City's landscape contractor.

To redeem the coupon the owner must agree to use the City contracted landscape company.

Owners present their coupon to contractor at the time of payment and 50% up to \$500 (max) is deducted from their final bill. The property owner will be responsible for the remaining invoice cost.

The City contracted landscape company will submit an invoice to the City of Edgewater to collect the balance from the coupon.

WHAT IS ELIGIBLE?

Emerald Ash Borer Treatment

The Emerald Ash Borer is not in Edgewater, but has been found in Arvada. An Ash Tree must meet specific conditions and be deemed suitable for treatment by the City Arborist.

Infested Tree Removal

Trees that have an untreatable insect or disease with no hope of recovery may be eligible for removal. Examples are Mountain Pine Beetle and Tussock Moth.

Preventative Tree Removal

Dead or dying trees can be dangerous, and the City of Edgewater encourages residents to remove affected trees and limbs.

Once a tree is at least 50% percent dead, the tree will never recover and should be removed. Large limbs (greater than six inches) that are dead and creating a hazard to surrounding areas may also be eligible for the program.

Planting

Plant a tree and get reimbursed! Buy a tree from the vendor of your choice and the City of Edgewater will reimburse you.

Homeowners must provide proof of tree removal, allow the City Arborist to verify the planting, and provide a receipt of purchase to the City to be eligible for reimbursement. The planting location must be pre-approved by City Arborist and the tree must be on the approved list - located on: www.EdgewaterCO.gov/Trees
