



Sustainability Board Vacancies

The Sustainability Board has three (3) upcoming vacancies for voluntary positions to serve two-year terms ending in 2026. The Sustainability Board consists of five voting members and one alternate member, appointed by the mayor, to support implementation of the *Edgewater Sustainability Plan*.

Members appointed to the Edgewater Sustainability Board advise the City Council and Mayor on all matters concerning Sustainability within the City. Board members may serve as category leads to support city projects and provide policy recommendations related to Edgewater's Land and Water, Waste and Materials, Energy, and Social Vibrancy sustainability goals. Members may also represent the Edgewater Sustainability program at city events, networking opportunities, and more.
