#### Cleaning Up After This Weekend's Wind Storm

Disposing of Downed Branches, Tree Limbs, and Other Commonly Asked Questions

The City of Edgewater Property owners are responsible for the prompt clean-up of trees on sidewalks and streets. The City is responsible for clearing trees off the roads for vehicles to pass. Please see below for more information on proper tree and branch removal.

### Q) Who do I report my power outage to?

A) Please report it to Xcel at 1-800-895-1999 or online at xcelenergy.com. Do not call the City of Edgewater!

## Q) I have broken tree limbs and/or branches on my utility lines. What do I do?

A) If the line is still intact and appears to pose no threat to people or property, please contact Xcel at 1-800-895-1999. If the power line is down or you are witnessing a dangerous situation, immediately call 911.

# Q) I have broken tree limbs; trees; and/or branches that have fallen onto the street and are impacting traffic. What do I do?

A) Please call **Bill Stines** with City of Edgewater Public Works at 303-359-1762

# Q) How do I dispose of fallen trees or large branches on my property that are too big to move or throw in a dumpster?

A) Residents should contact a private tree company for removal. ### Q) I have tree branches near my curb. Who is responsible for those?

A) City municipal code requires property owners to remove all dead trees or broken limbs. The City has opened a branch drop off (starting 12pm on Tuesday, 4/9 on the North side of the Edgewater Public Works Building / 5990 W. 20th Ave.), and a list of tree contractors licensed with the City is available on our website. If you have a hardship case Public Works will see how we can assist, please contact City of Edgewater Public Works Supervisor Bill Stines at 303-359-1762.

#### Q) Where can I take tree limbs and fallen branches that I've collected?

A) Residents can drop off branches starting 12pm on **Tuesday**, **4/9** on the North side of the Edgewater Public Works Building at 5990 W. 20th Ave.
