Details

Earlier this morning (10/15/2024), a call was received at approx. 2:15 a.m. of several shots fired in the 2200 block of Ames Street in the city of Edgewater. Edgewater Police Officers responded to the area and found that two (2) residences had been struck by gunfire. Evidence obtained from the scene indicated the use of a rifle that struck front windows and front doors as numerous bullets entered the residences. Fortunately, none of the occupants at either location were injured.

Video surveillance obtained from a nearby residence captured individuals running from the scene after the shooting but no other suspect information has been obtained at this time. Investigators are asking anyone that might have heard or seen anything related to this incident to contact Detective Chad Slaven at 720-763-3024 or cslaven@edgewaterpd.com. Any residents that have exterior surveillance cameras are asked to check their footage near the time of the incident and contact Detective Slaven or the Edgewater Police Department if they locate anything.
