

Commercial New Business Tenant Information

Any commercial changes of occupancy, changes of use, expansions of use, or expansions of occupancy into more space in the same building, *regardless of whether there will be any construction or remodeling to prepare the space for the new tenant*, require a building permit and inspection prior to operating the business in the space. This requires:

Plan showing existing floor plan and proposed new layout. The plan should be understandable and reasonably to scale, and should include a graphic of the location of the space within the building, relative to other spaces and the parking lot.

If the building itself is being expanded, a survey is also required.

A completed building permit application. Applications must be submitted through the Building Department. More information can be found at: <u>https://edgewaterco.com/building</u>

Please note that any change of business tenant in a commercial space requires a building permit and inspection, regardless of whether any tenant remodel work is being done, even in the same size space, or if the business is expanding or moving to a different space in the same building.
